

Just west of Lamont, Oklahoma sits this serene 99 +/-acre farm. Situated perfectly along the northern banks of the Salt Fork Arkansas River this property has a modern modular home for full-time living as well as a gorgeous river camp for fun in the sun, floating all day in the river. This farm has an excellent balance of pasture, play, and woods to hunt.

Approaching the property, you will notice the large overhanging trees that provide great cover and security for all livestock and wildlife. As you enter the farm, a nice gravel entrance snakes by the old cattle corral that was used many years ago for shipping livestock. The original farmstead barn is still in great shape. A few simple improvements and this would be an excellent cleaning shed for deer season! This farm is anchored by a 1,900+ square foot modern double-wide overlooking the entire river bottom. Containing 3 large bedrooms and 2 full baths there is plenty of room for a growing family or large hunting camp! The kitchen is large enough for family gatherings and plenty of room to relax around the living room. Just a quick walk away is the fun-filled river camp. A 320 square foot camping shack that has a gorgeous porch view overlooking the river. This cabin has a heater and windows for an all-season camping experience.

Just off the campsite area and tributary the river sits an area that is graded for a future wetland. This section of northern Oklahoma is known for its excellent waterfowl hunting. The property provides all you need for successful late-season hunting with river access, a well that has been drilled next to your wetland, and plenty of neighboring ag fields for ducks to feed in. River bottoms in this area provide excellent cover for deer escaping the vast open farm country that Grant County has as well as water and cool banks to beat the summer heat. This area has numerous cottonwoods that have anchored the riverbanks to form growing shaded travel corridors. The farm is managed with a strong feeding program and light hunting to maximize age class as well as deer genetics.

This farm is great for anyone looking to grow the family farm and ranch operation or just looking for a base camp for your hunting and fishing needs. Peaceful, quiet river camps are difficult to find. 


AERIAL MAP


