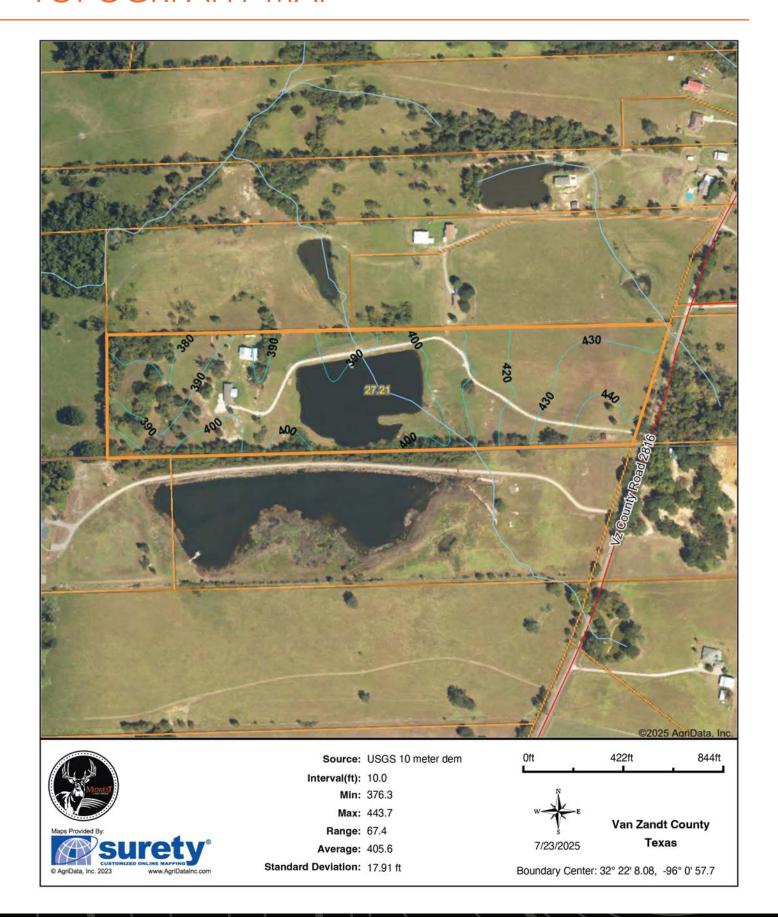




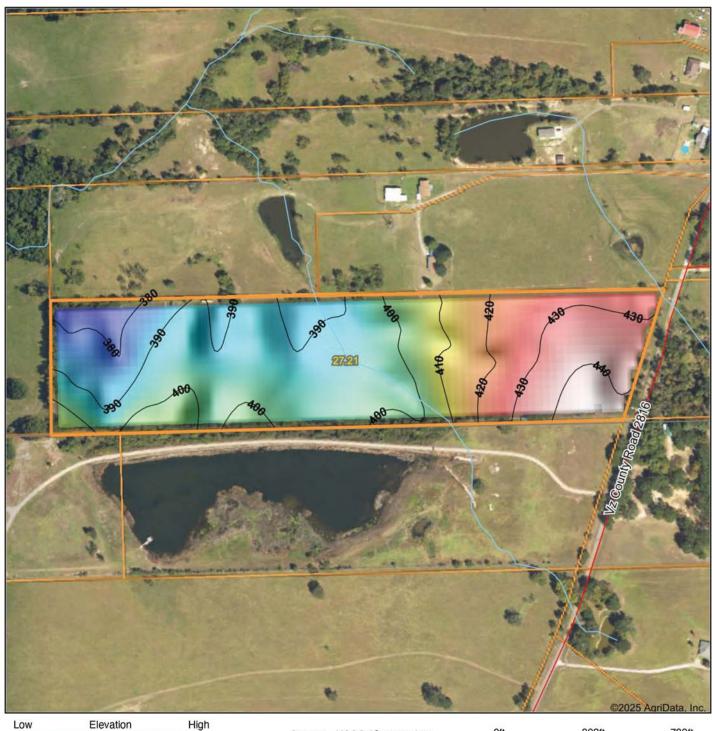




### TOPOGRPAHY MAP

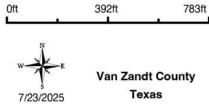

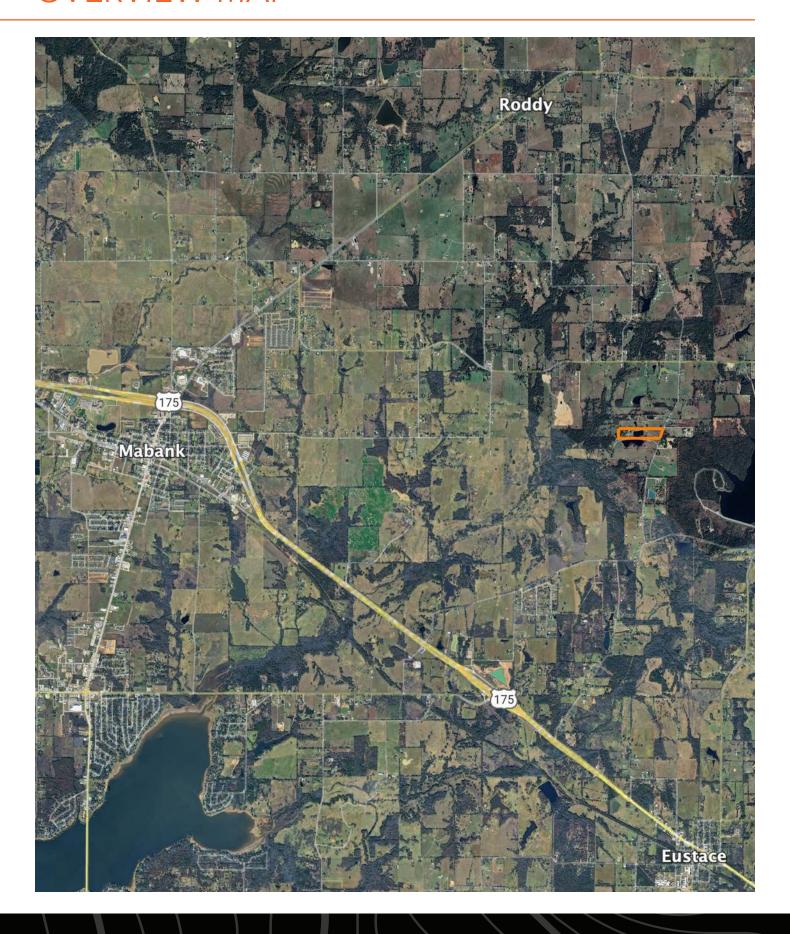
