Whether you want to build your forever home or enjoy a recreational getaway, this property shouldn't be missed.

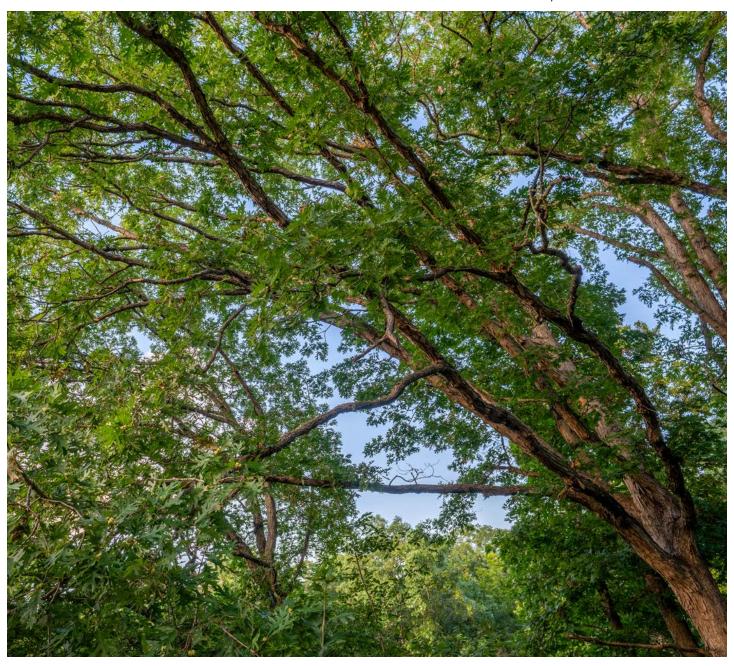

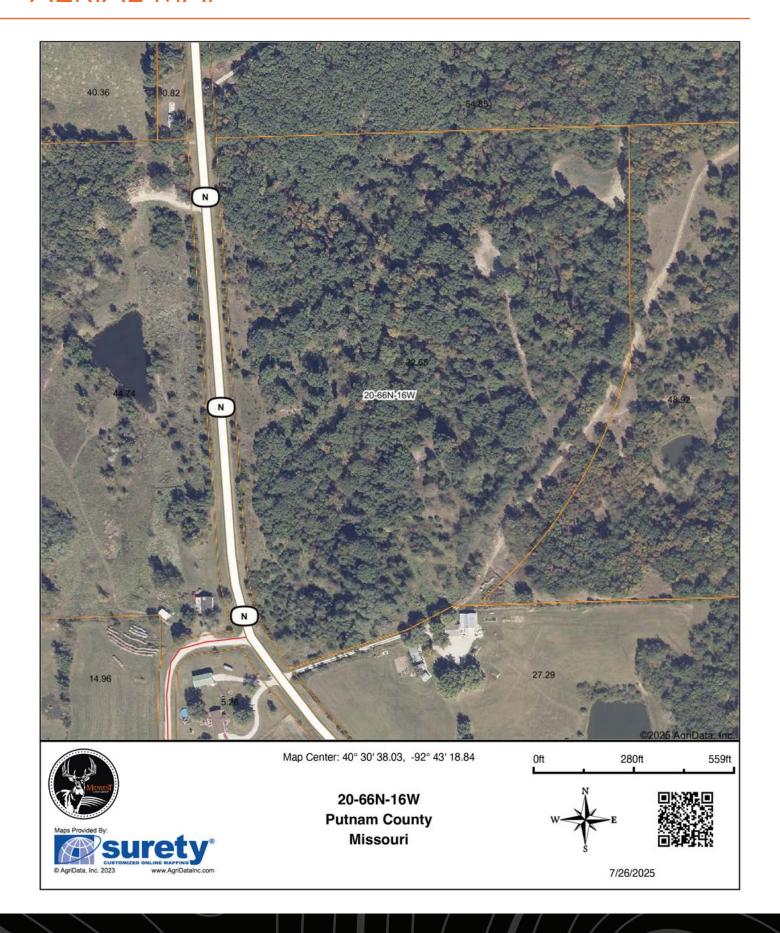

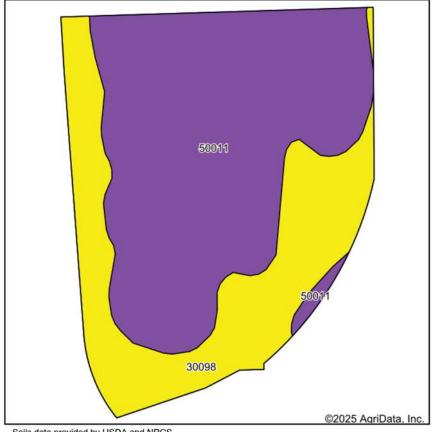
