There is a well-established and maintained trail system throughout the ranch, providing access to every stand and box blind and every boat ramp on the lakes. This ranch offers the unmatched opportunity to host the entire family for annual deer camp to summer fishing outings. The property features approximately 240 +/- acres of productive tillable ground that provides consistent annual income and doubles as the major food source and draw for wildlife. Approximately 208 +/- acres of mature hardwood timber, with a great mix of red and white oaks, along with a strong stand of walnuts. There are 7 different pit lakes, for approximately 16 surface acres of beautiful, clear water, that provide incredible fishing opportunities for bass and crappie. The balance of the ranch is made up of an incredible warm-season grass stand that creates excellent bedding and nesting cover for wildlife.

The lodge is the core of the property, a beautiful custom-

built home, completed in 2012, that serves as the true centerpiece of the ranch. The lodge features three spacious bedrooms, three full bathrooms, and two half baths, along with a full kitchen and open living area anchored by a beautiful stone fireplace. Large windows and vaulted ceilings bring the outdoors in and give panoramic views of the lakes, timber, and open fields, creating a perfect setting for relaxation or entertaining guests. The most appealing part of the home is the expansive outdoor deck and awesome outdoor fireplace, perfectly blending the indoor and outdoor living areas. Whether hosting family gatherings or enjoying a quiet weekend retreat, the lodge offers year-round comfort and a touch of rustic elegance.

The 60'x100' shop, complete with concrete floors, water, and electricity, is the perfect setup for storing all your gear and equipment, and a game cleaning station. Attached to the shop is a 40'x50' addition with horse stables and a tack room. Next to the shop sits a recent, nicely remodeled three-bedroom, two-bath modular home, which is currently used as additional guest accommodations, but would also be ideal for caretaker housing, or just continue to use it for overflow lodging.

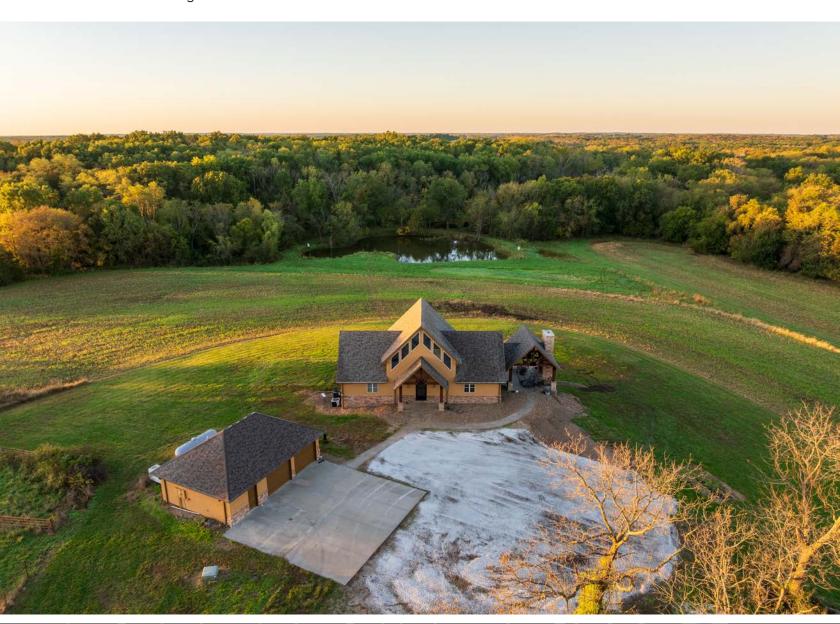

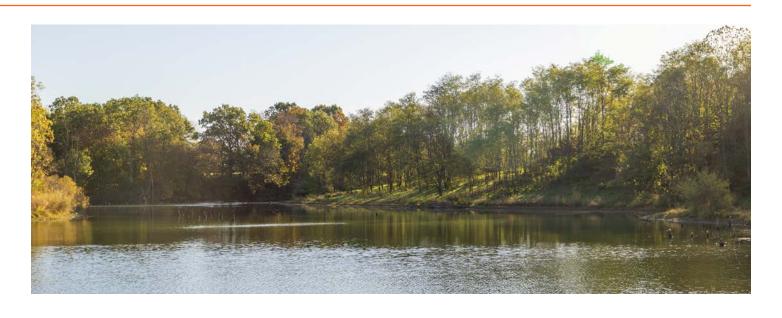

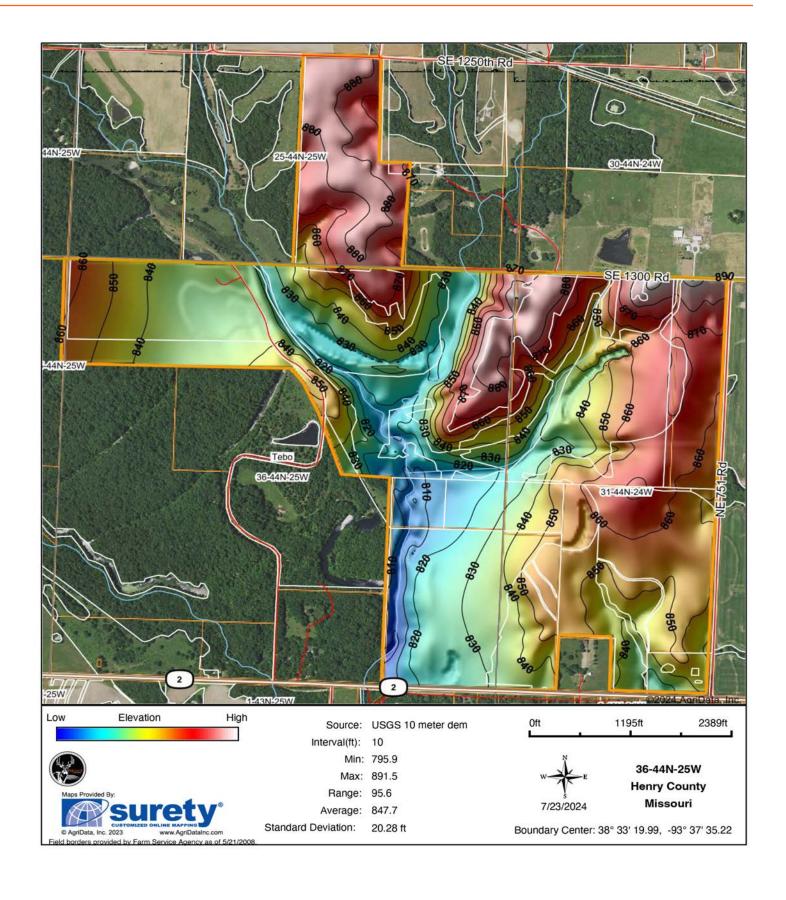

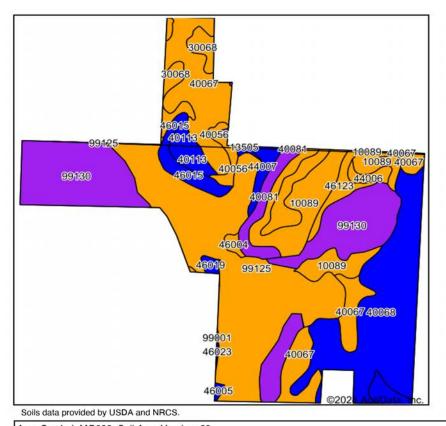
AERIAL MAP

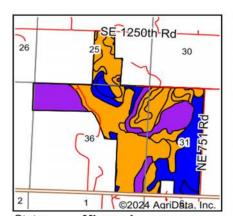


HILLSHADE MAP
