With full perimeter fencing and cross-fencing in place, herd rotation is definitely an option.

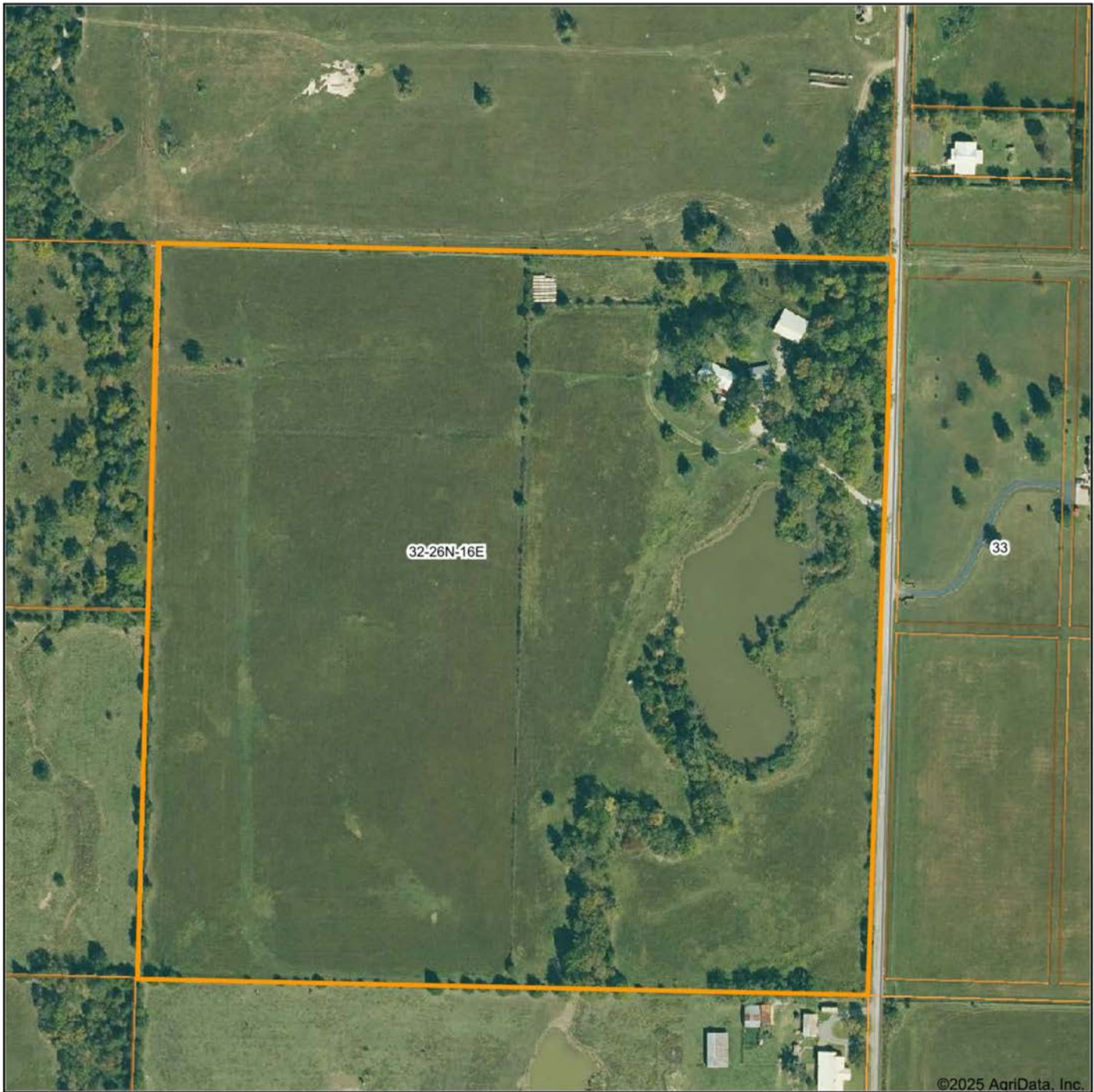

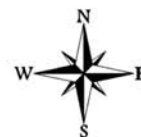

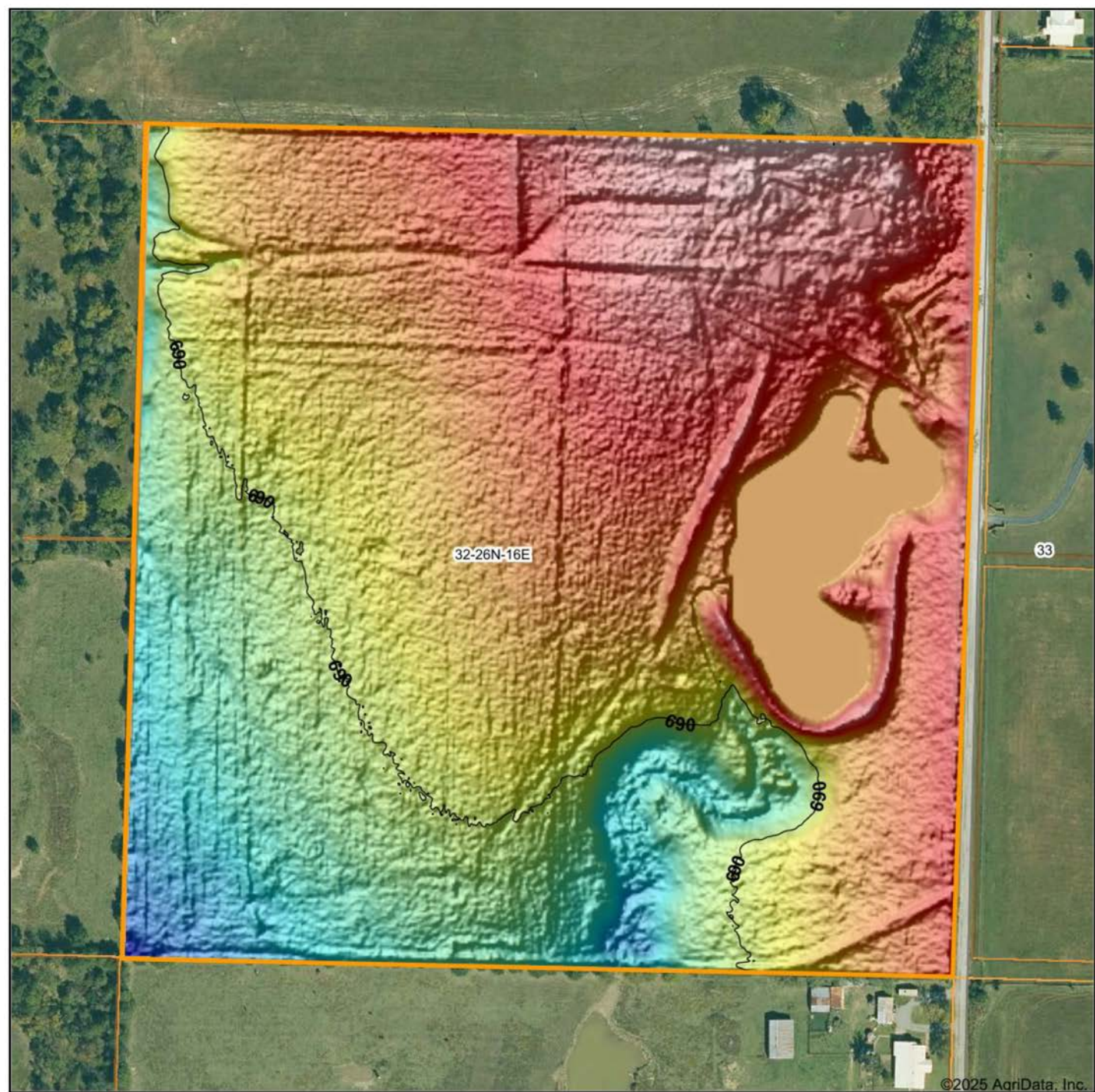

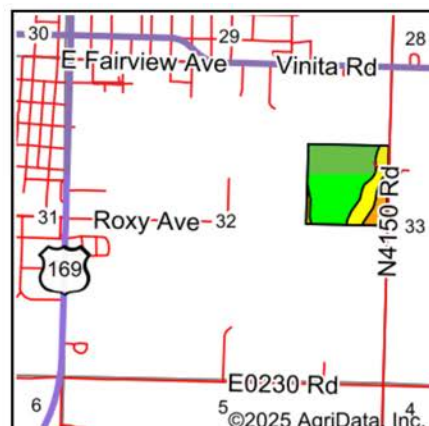
