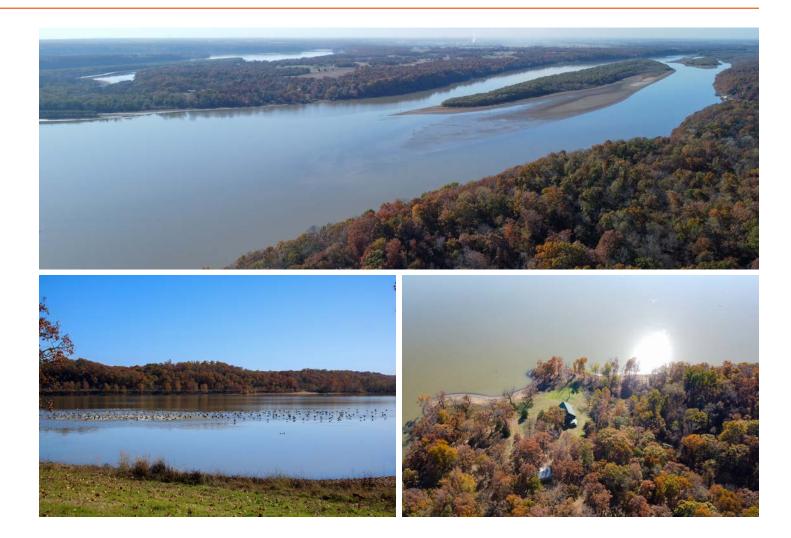

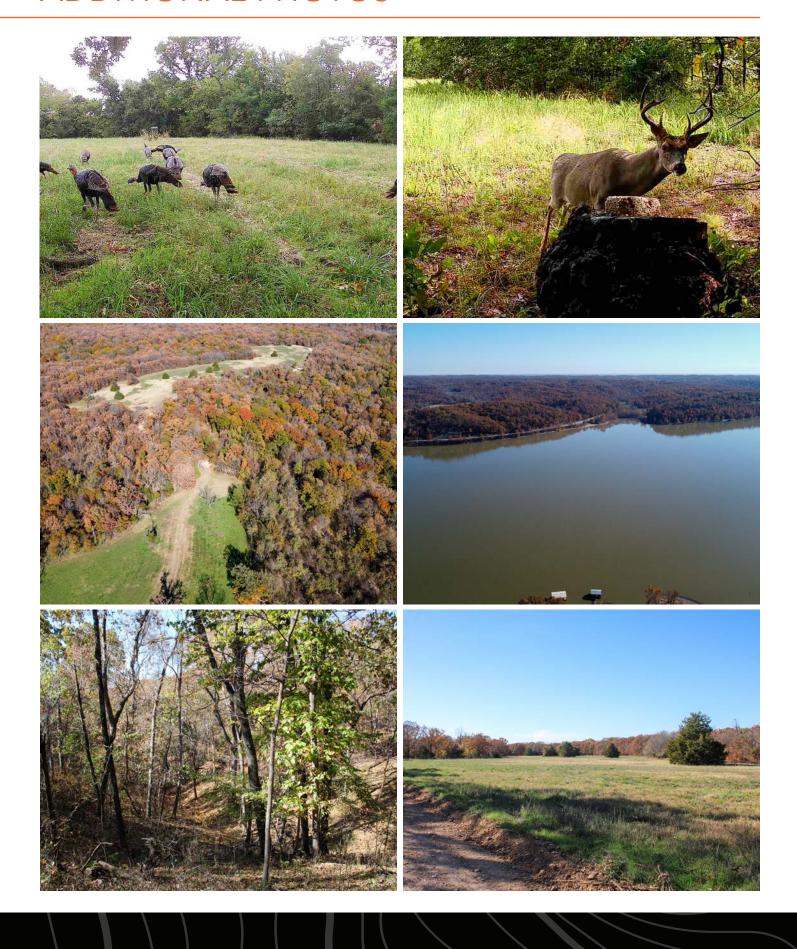

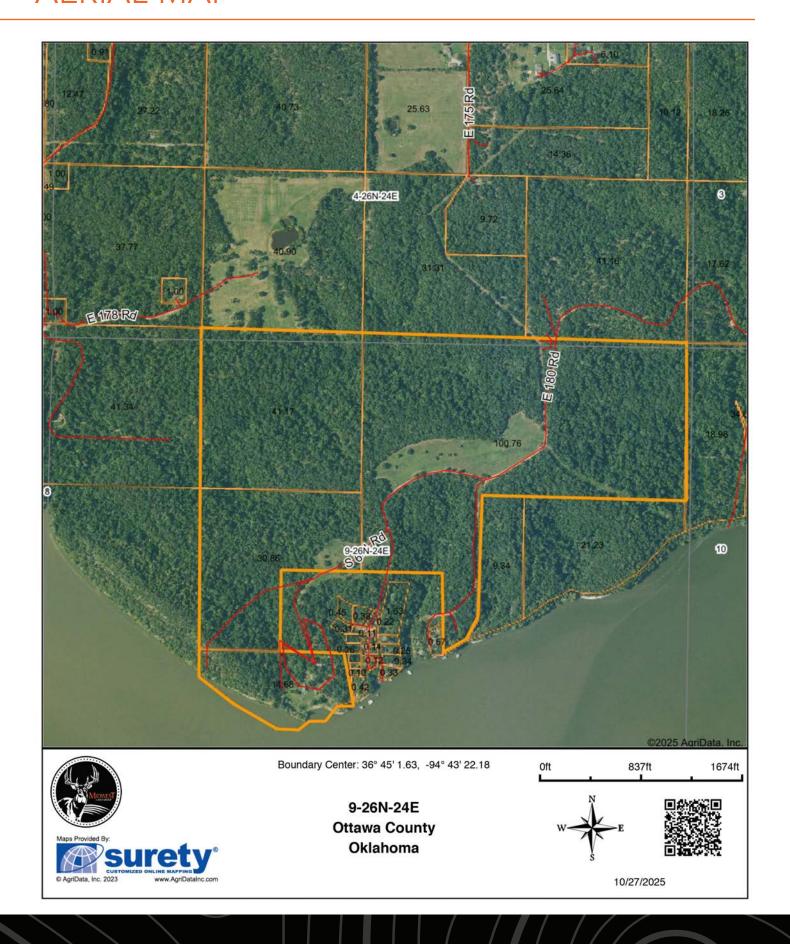

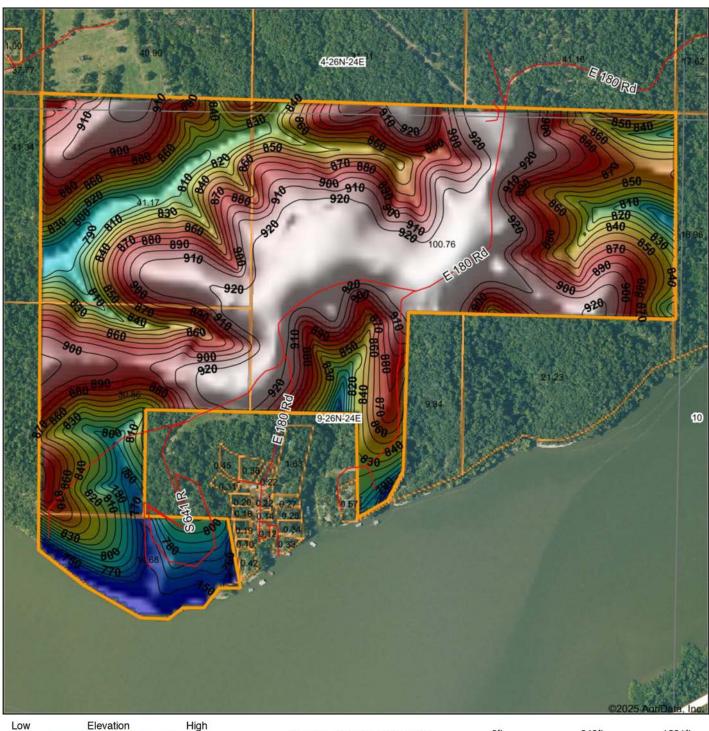

#### **OVERVIEW MAP**

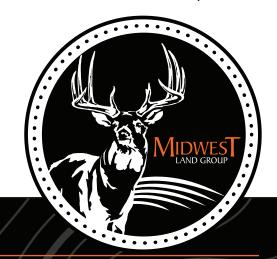
