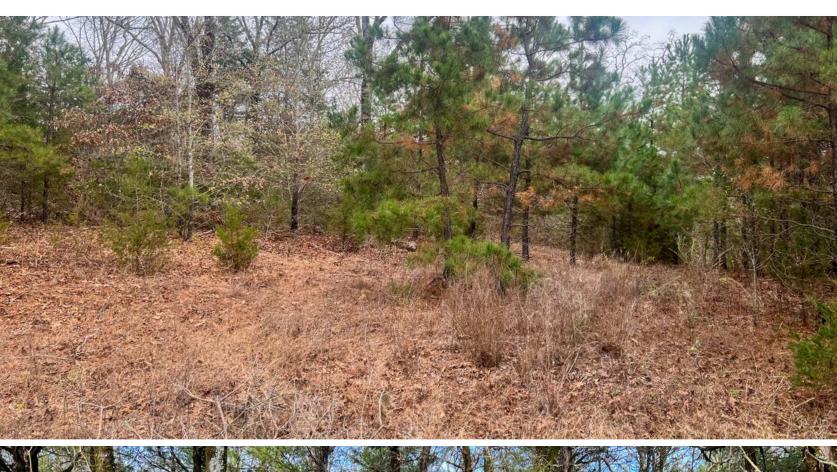

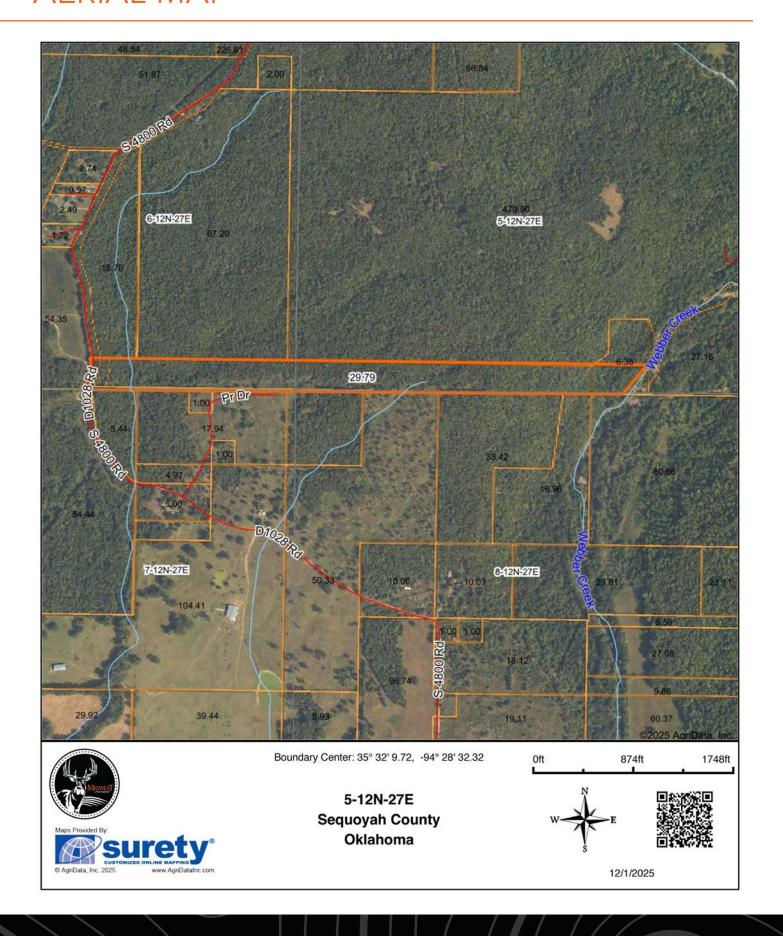

HILLSHADE MAP





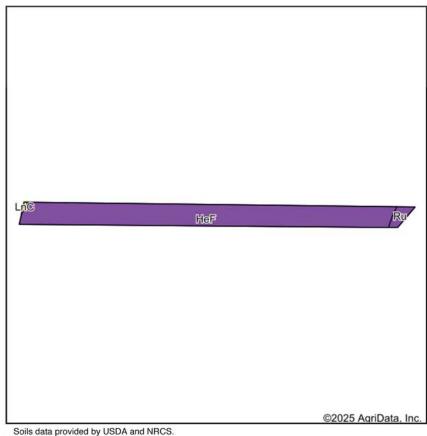
