# LIBERTY LODGE - A LEGACY OZARKS MOUNTAIN RETREAT

---

Set at the end of a long, private drive that meanders through 171+/- acres, the 2,400 square-foot, 3 bedroom, 3 bath custom log home was designed to belong to its setting. Rather than clearing the land, the structure was fitted into it. Mature hardwoods were preserved. The creek below was used to create a serene lake teeming with wildlife. Sightlines were protected. From a distance, the home appears to rise naturally from the terrain, anchored by stone and framed by forest.

Construction emphasized longevity over speed. Massive hand-peeled logs were selected and placed with intention. Exposed beams and solid-wood surfaces define the interior, while native stone was used extensively throughout the landscaping and the home, most notably in the great room fireplace, constructed stone by stone as the visual and functional heart of the residence.

Inside, the layout favors gathering without excess. The kitchen was designed as a working centerpiece, anchored by a substantial stone island and surrounded by custom cabinetry and high-end appliance finishes. Living spaces flow easily from one to the next, with large windows drawing in light, treetops, and views of the water below.

The home offers multiple living levels, allowing for both privacy and togetherness. Lofted and upper-level spaces provide guest accommodations, while the lower level was designed for extended stays, recreation, or quiet

retreat. Each space reflects restraint, proportion, and purpose. Additional features include a gun safe room with a workbench in the basement, a greenhouse, horse corral, and miles of trails right out your door. Whether you're riding horses, gardening, hunting, or simply enjoying the quiet, this property offers a lifestyle that's becoming harder to find.

Water defines the land. A clear, spring-creek winds through the property beneath rock shelves and shaded banks, providing a constant natural presence. Beyond the creek, purpose-built ponds were carefully constructed and stocked, adding both function and serenity to the landscape. Wildlife moves freely throughout the acreage, and the surrounding forest remains largely unchanged.

The property spans 171+/- acres, adjoining protected national forest land and offering the rare assurance of permanent privacy and ultimate hunting opportunity. Despite the seclusion, the estate also remains within close proximity to the waters and recreation of Table Rock Lake—creating a balance of access and retreat that is increasingly difficult to find.

This home was built with legacy in mind, with respect for the land and an expectation of longevity. A place meant to be returned to, lived in fully, and ultimately passed on. Properties of this scale, craftsmanship, and setting rarely come available—particularly those with a craftsmanship this intentional.

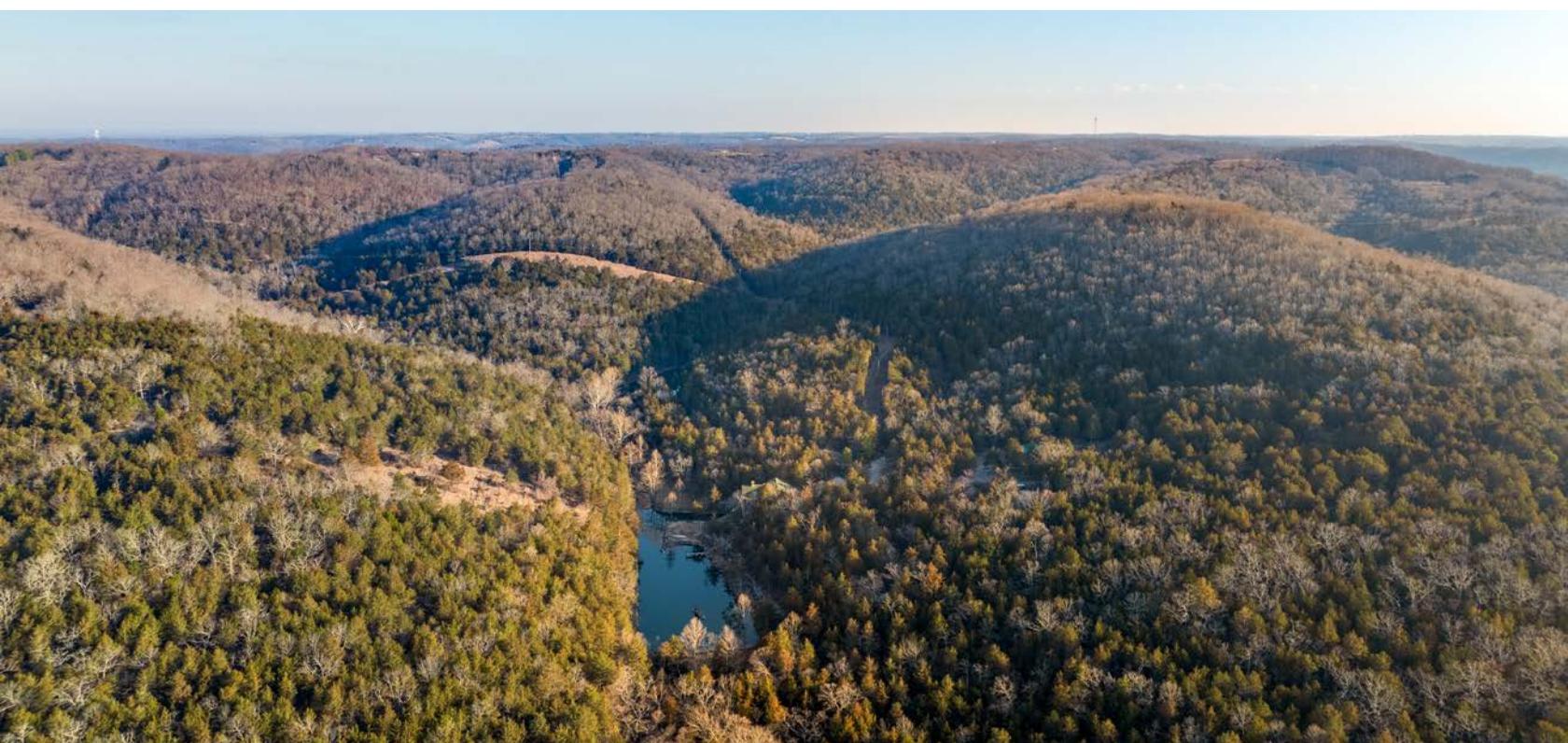

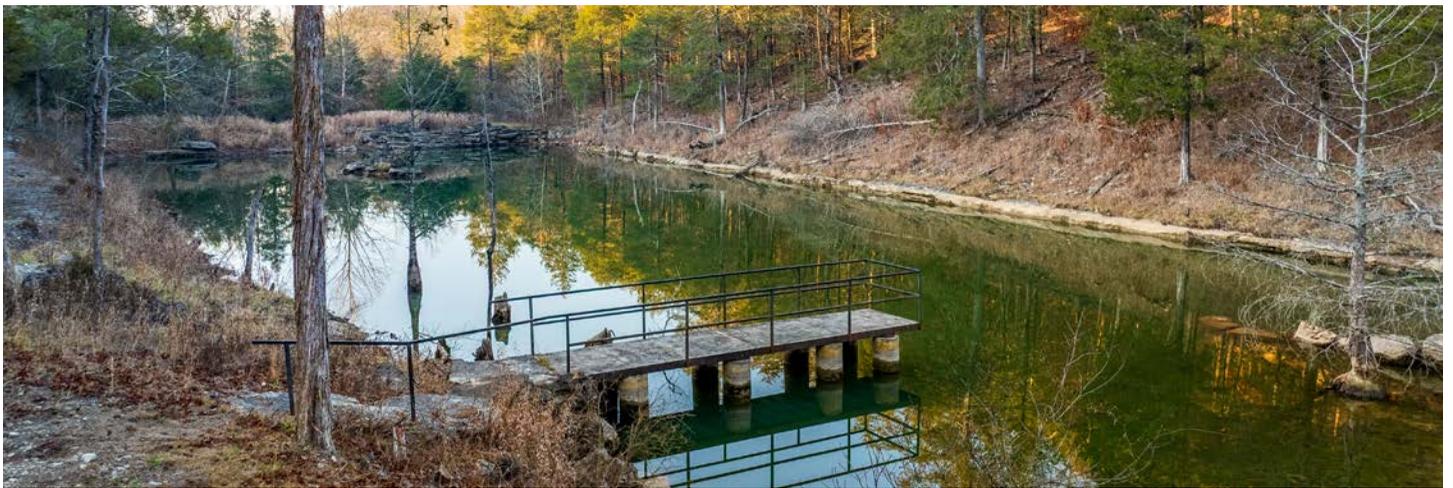
# YEAR-ROUND OZARK CREEK

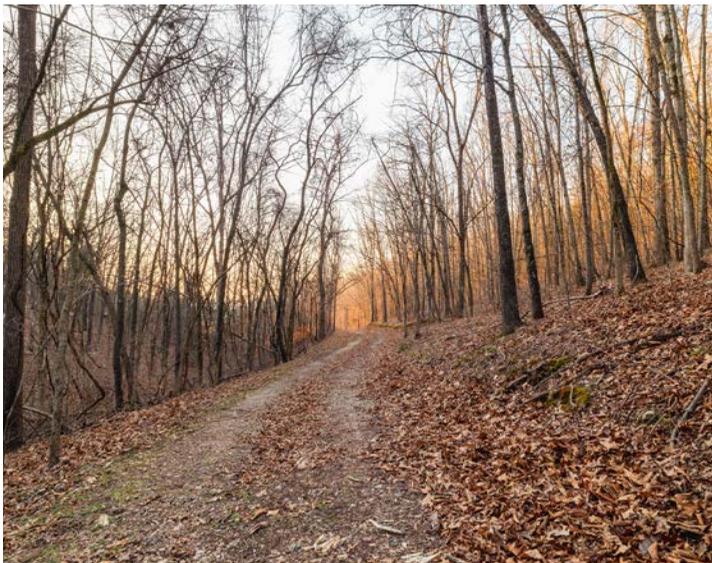

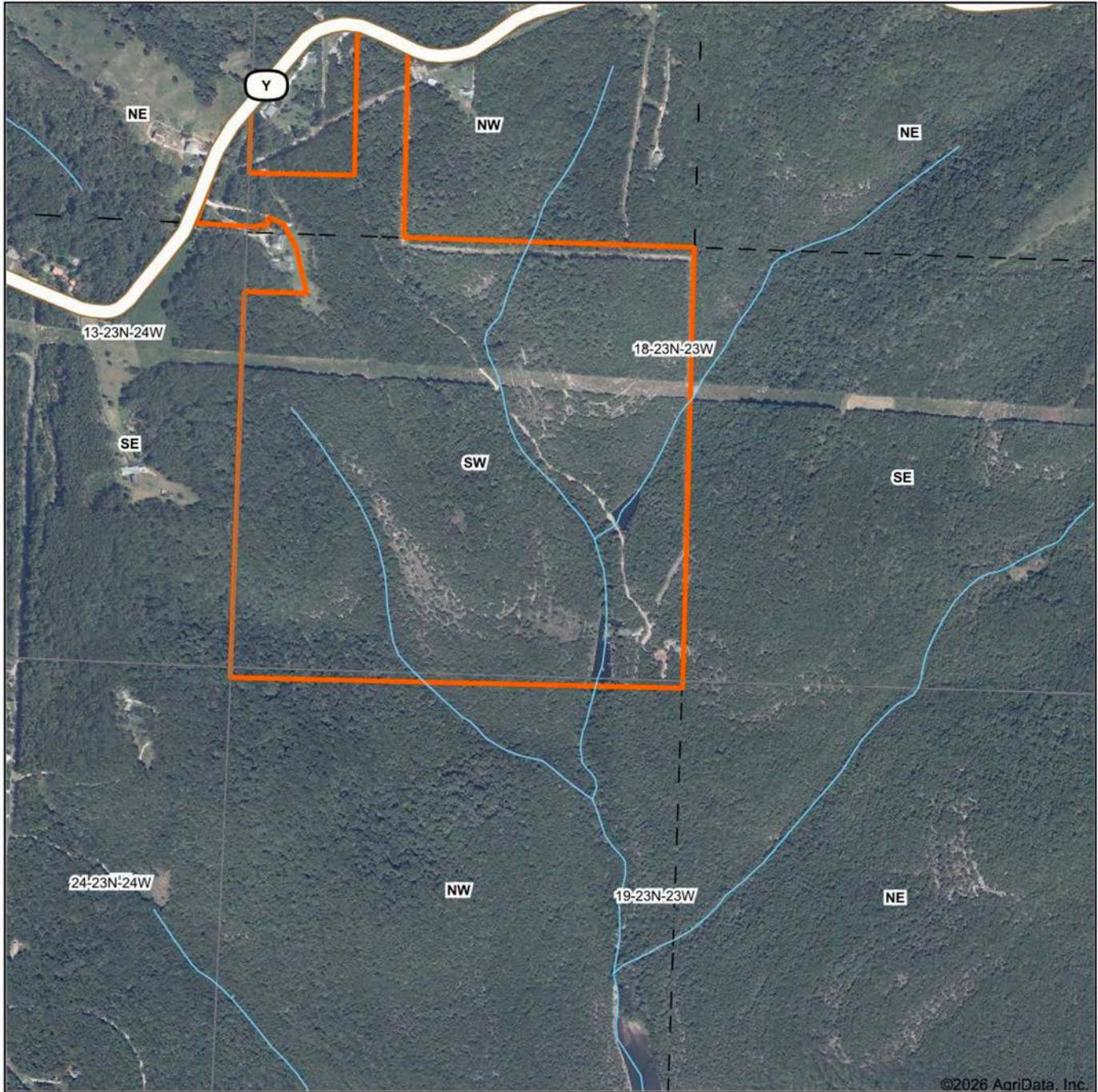

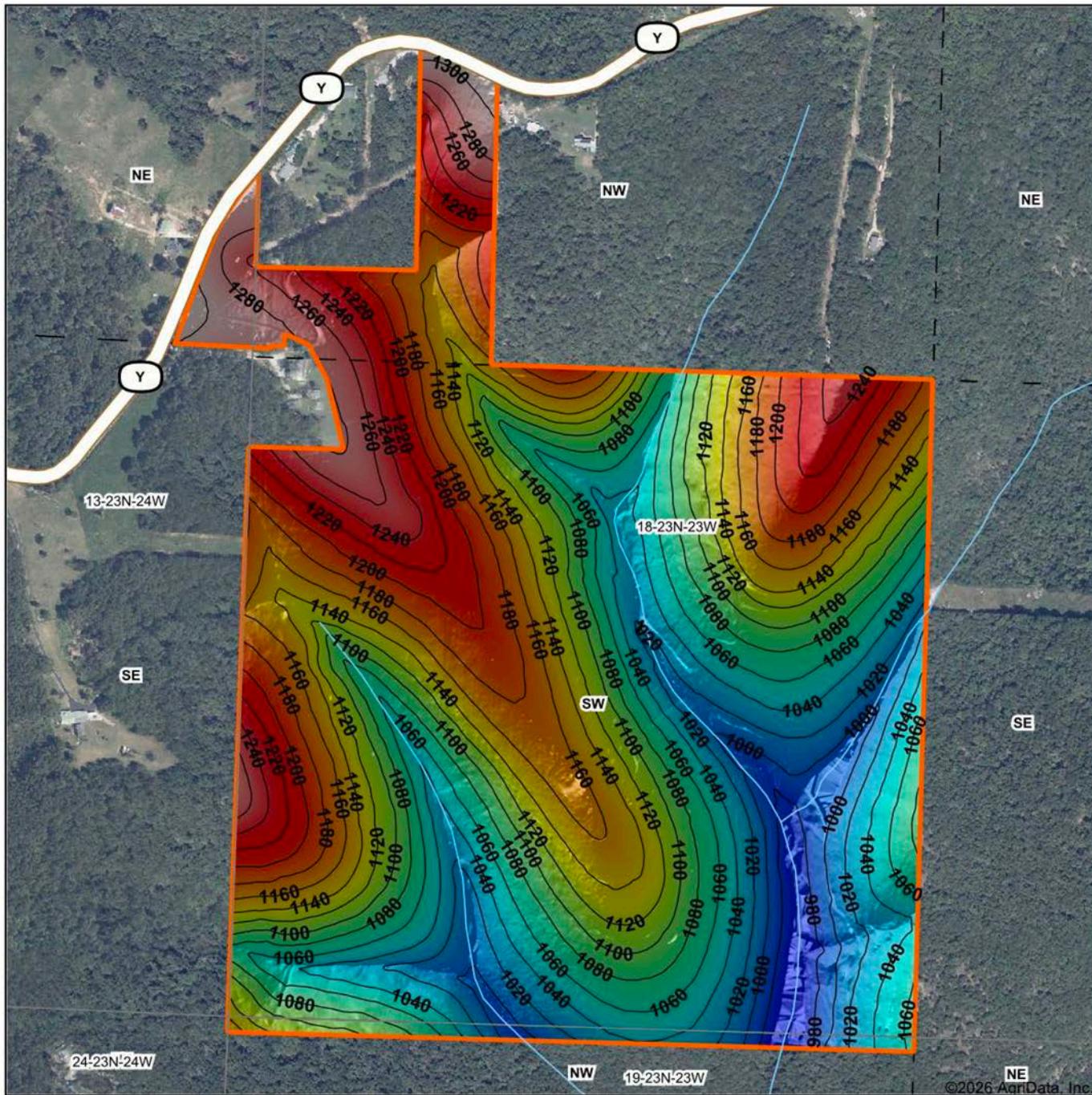

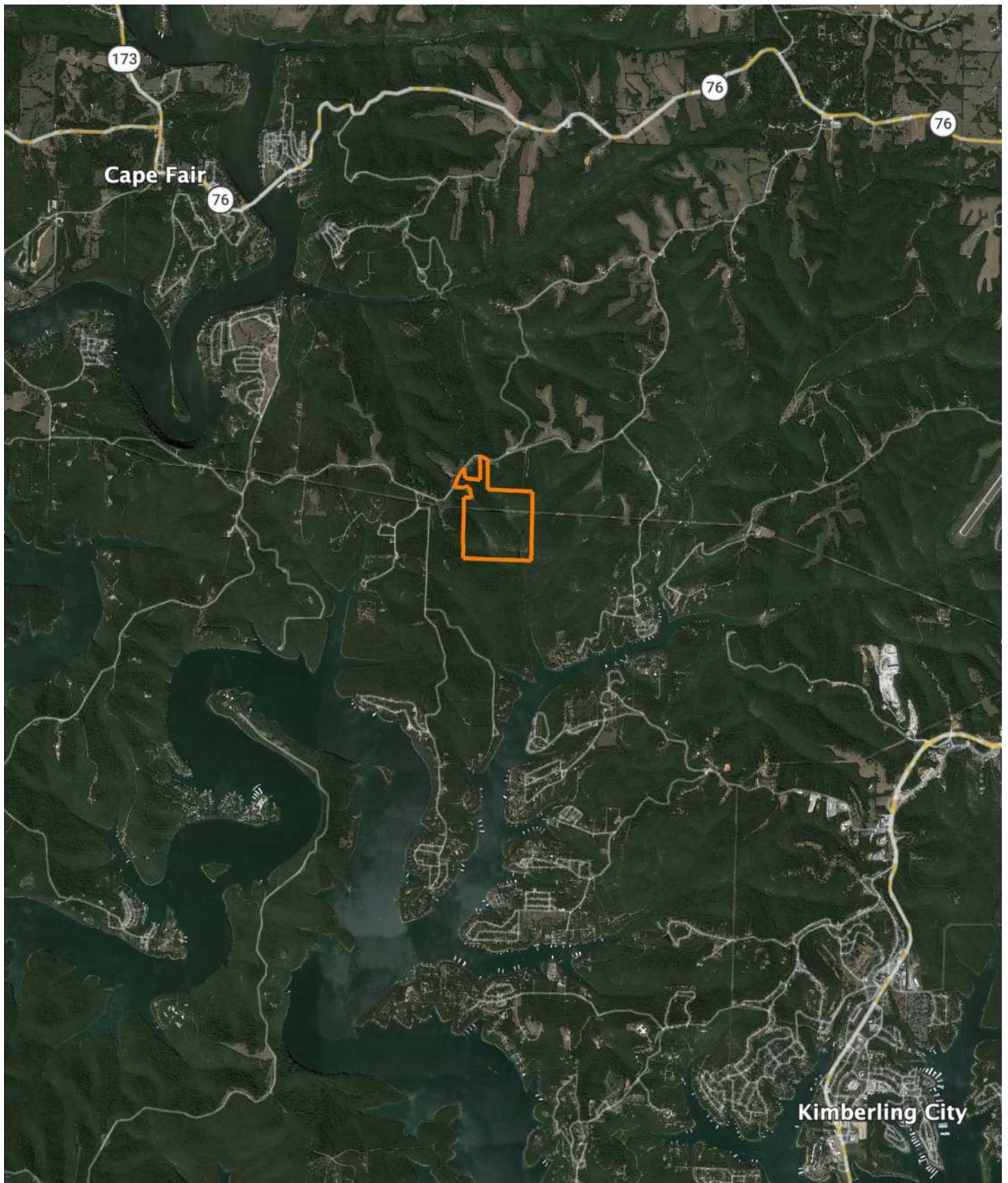
