This property offers a rare combination of privacy, recreational opportunities, income-producing potential, and improvements, making it an ideal setup for a hunting property, hobby farm, or weekend getaway.

The property features more than 20 acres of timber, several open fields, and a diverse layout that provides excellent habitat and recreational opportunities. Several of the fields have been in production up until this year, giving the new owner the flexibility to continue farming, convert acreage to food plots, pasture, or manage it for wildlife.

For the outdoorsman, this property is ready to go. There are two stocked fishing ponds and a trail system running throughout the property, providing easy access to the timber, fields, ponds, and hunting areas. Included with the sale are two large, spacious Oak Ridge hunting blinds, already positioned and ready for the upcoming hunting seasons.

Tucked away from the road and completely surrounded by privacy is a 30'x40' barn with living quarters. The barn is essentially off-grid, currently powered by a generator with water brought in, making it an excellent recreational retreat or base camp. Its secluded location provides a level of privacy that is hard to find.

Additional improvements include a smaller barn and a Conex storage container, providing plenty of room for equipment, tools, and recreational gear. The property is also being offered with an impressive package of farm and property-maintenance equipment, including a John Deere 2240 tractor, tiller, mower, disc, and additional equipment shown in the listing photos.

Whether you're looking for a turnkey hunting and fishing property, a private country retreat, a working farm, or a place to build and enjoy for years to come, this 80 +/- acre property offers an exceptional combination of land, improvements, equipment, and privacy in a highly desirable area of Southeast Kansas.



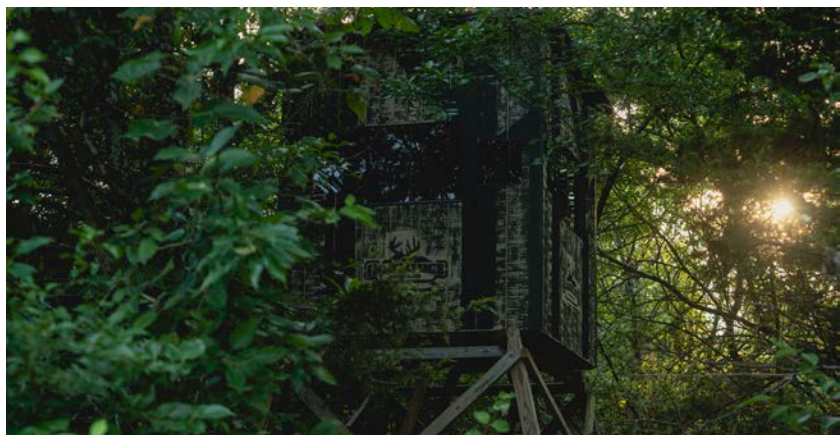

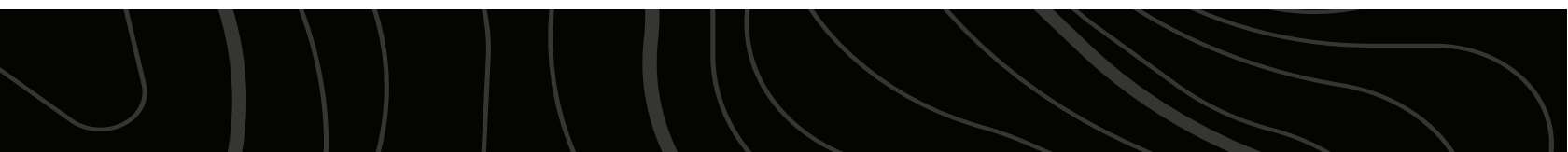

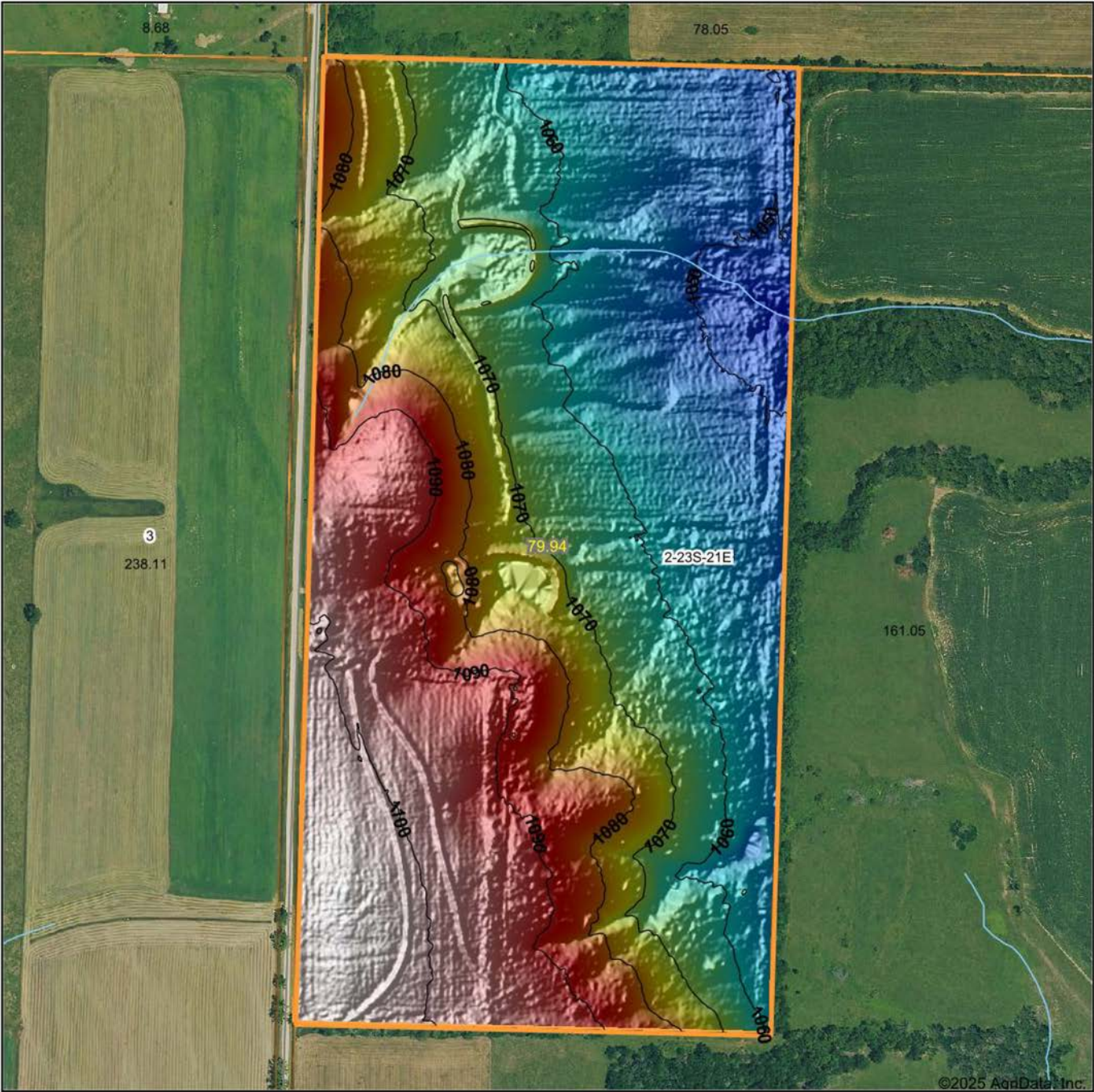

HILLSHADE MAP



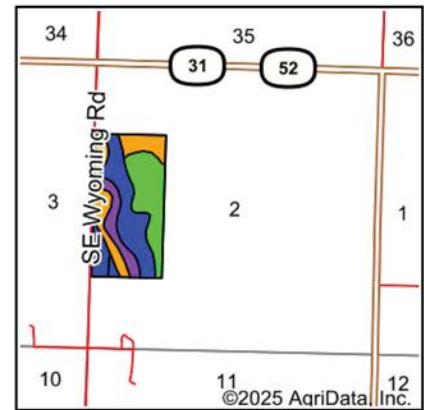
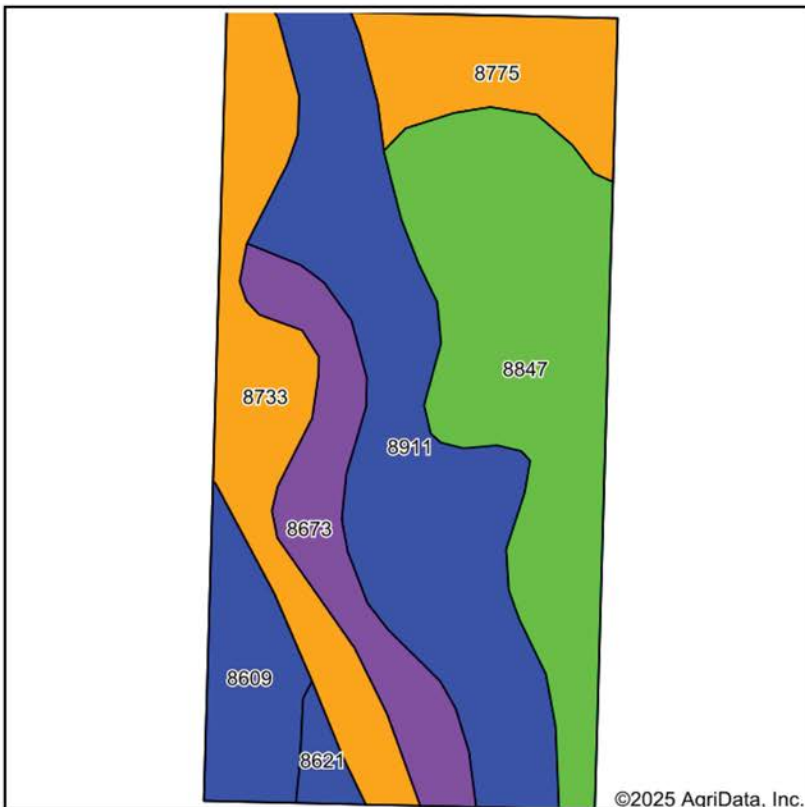

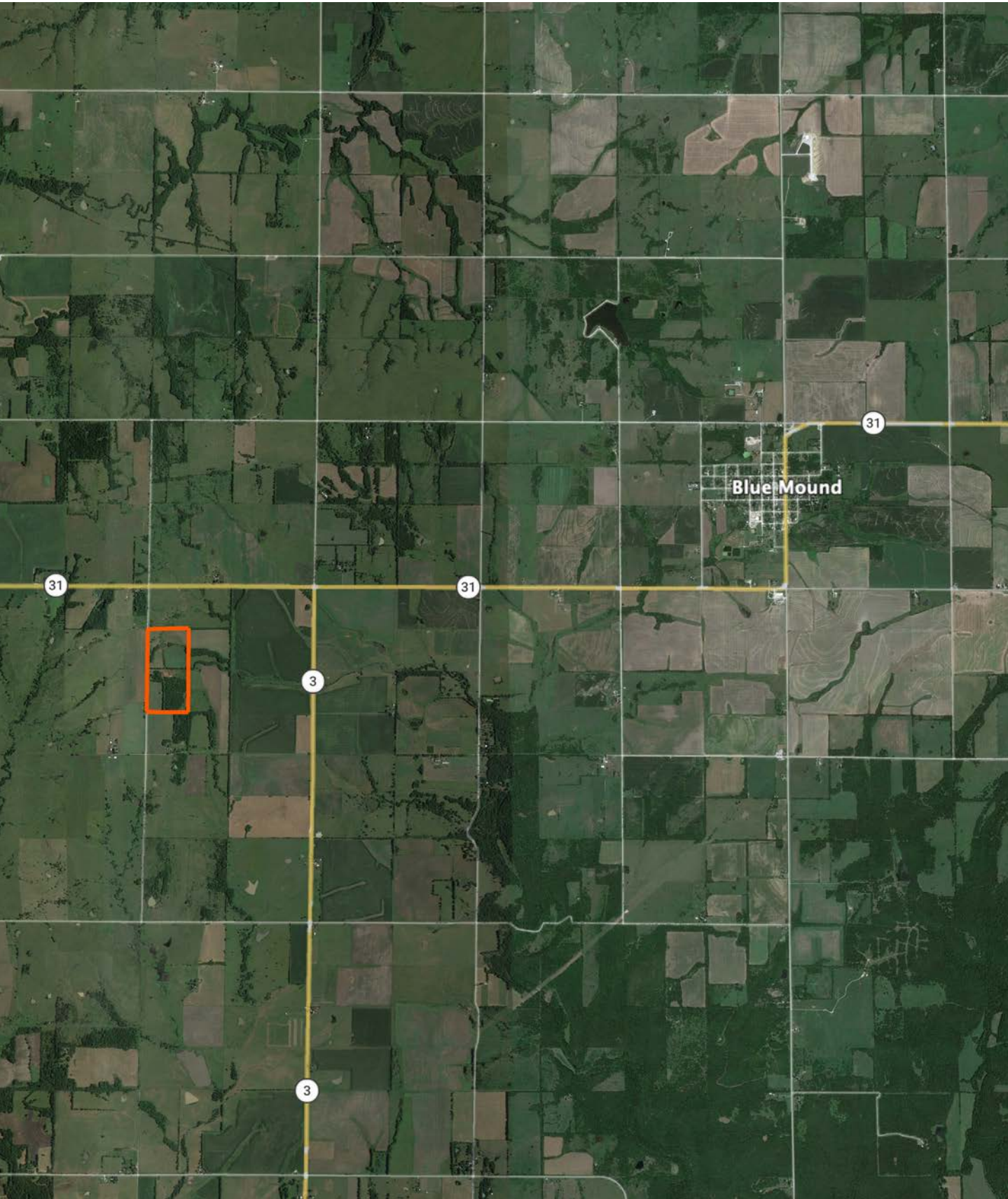
