Set on 20 surveyed acres just 35 minutes from the Kansas City metro, this versatile country property combines a beautifully remodeled 1926 farmhouse with productive acreage, excellent improvements, and room to enjoy the rural lifestyle. The property is fenced and divided into multiple pastures, with hay production, approximately 5 wooded acres, abundant wildlife, hunting opportunities, a garden, chicken coop, and beautiful views across the surrounding countryside.

At the heart of the property is a charming two-story farmhouse offering approximately 1,840 square feet with four bedrooms and two bathrooms. Originally built in 1926, the home has been thoughtfully remodeled while retaining the character that makes an older farmhouse special. A spacious covered deck provides an inviting place to relax and take in the views, while a laundry and mudroom adds both functionality and rustic charm. Major improvements include newer HVAC equipment, roof and siding, along with a modern electrical panel and updated wiring. The home also offers both a wood

boiler and propane furnace for heating flexibility, as well as a two-car garage.

The property is exceptionally well equipped with a 40'x50' structural-steel shop featuring insulation, a concrete floor, electricity, water, and its own bathroom. Two additional barns provide valuable space for livestock, hay, equipment, or storage. With multiple fenced pastures and productive ground already being utilized for hay, the acreage is well suited for horses, cattle, a small farming operation, or anyone looking for a self-sufficient country setting.

Located in the Lathrop School District and within an easy drive of the Kansas City metro, this property offers an appealing balance of privacy, productivity, and accessibility. For buyers looking for additional acreage, approximately 25 adjoining acres are also available, creating the opportunity to expand the property to roughly 45 acres.

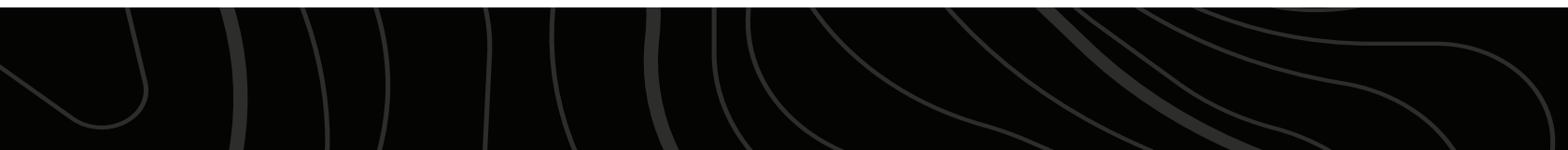

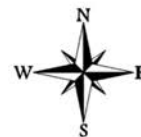

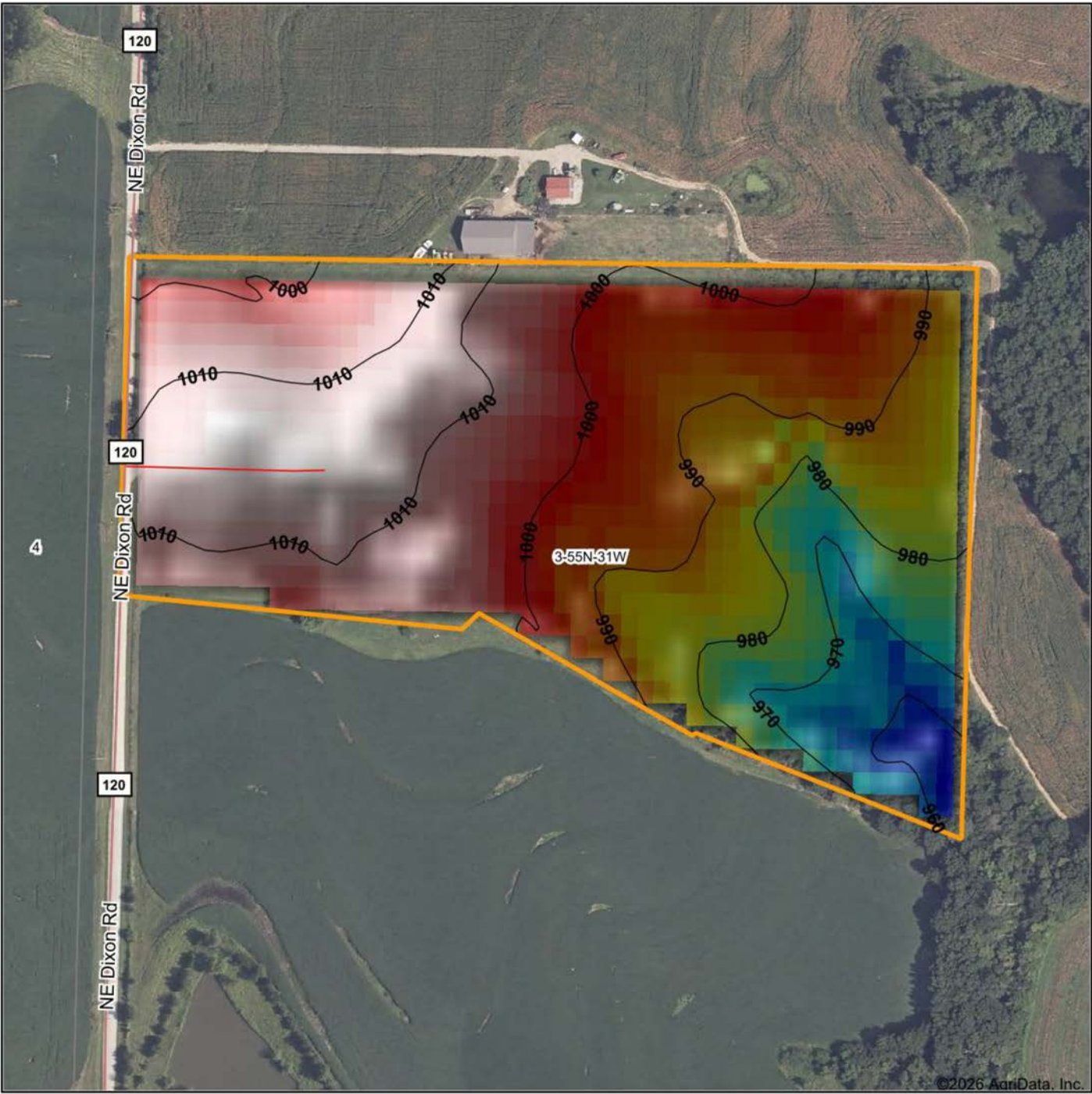

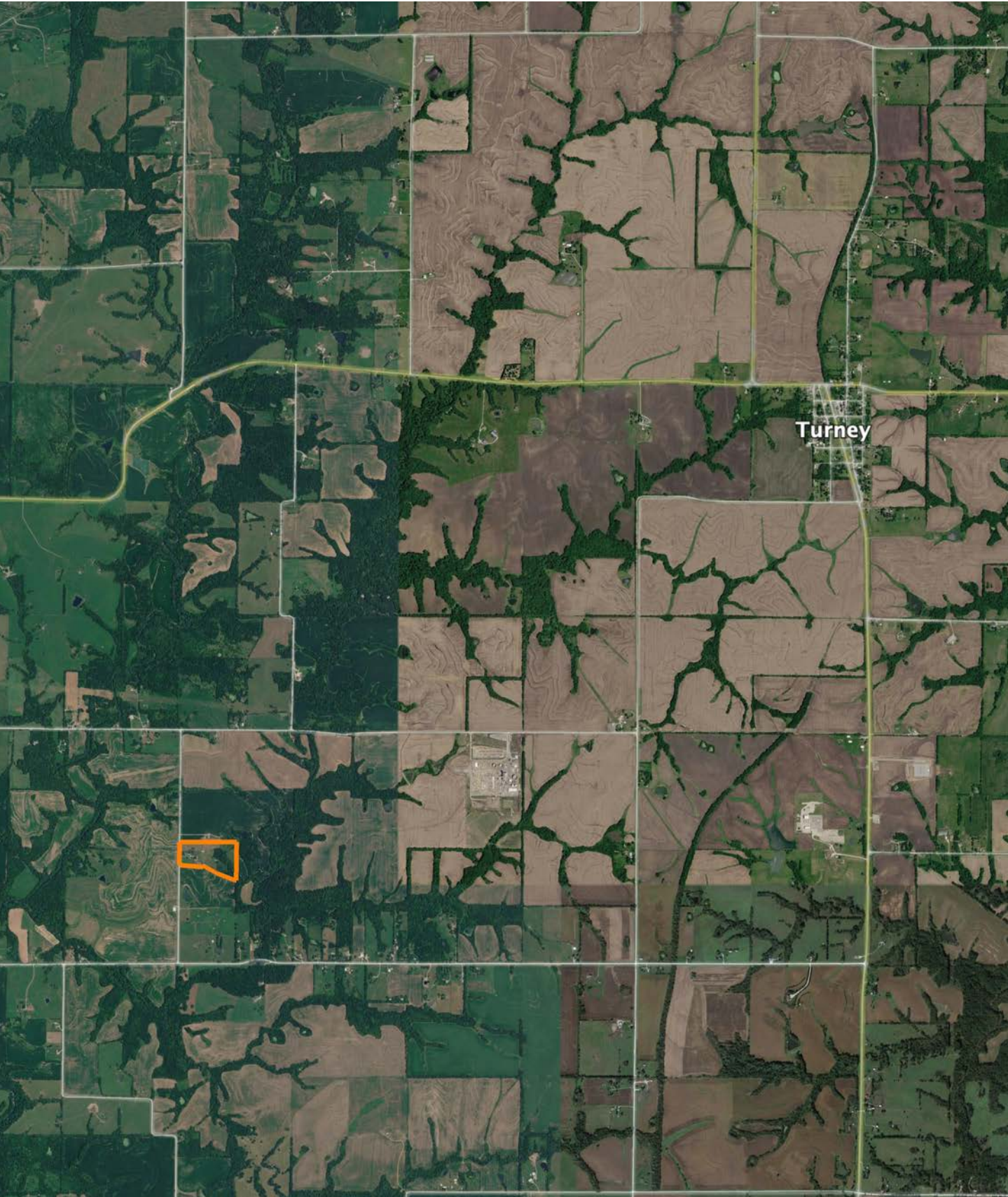
